### Mission

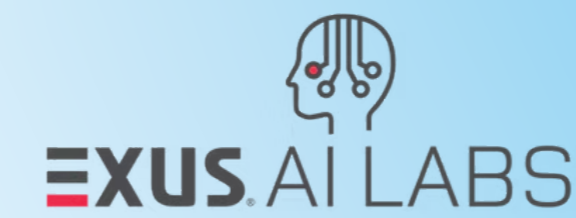
